

Position Description: League Delegate

The League Delegate is the primary communications link between the Club and the League. Duties include but are not limited to:

- a. Represent the Club at League Meetings by seeking the opinion of the Club's Football Operations and Executive Committee(s) on key issues prior to the League meeting and representing the collective view of the Club at League meetings.
- b. Become the focal point from which all leagues issues should be channelled to and from the Club.
- c. Canvas views from the Club Committee on contentious items and ensure the Club provides responses to the league on all key items requested.
- d. Attend all District Meetings and Club Committee Meetings.
- e. To report all relevant information from the above meetings to the Club.
- f. To provide information or feed-back from the Club at meetings as requested by the Executive of the League.
- g. To be aware of the Club's views on specific matters and be prepared to vote on these issues at League meetings.

The League Delegate is a member of the General Committee and reports to the Secretary.
